Lots of work happening around here

If you look around, you can see all the wonderful progress occurring each day. Here is a summary of the work being done:

Center wing project: The old vinyl on the moveable walls has been stripped off and surfaces have been sanded and prepped for the application of the new vinyl covering. Painters have started with the primer coat on the exterior block walls. Carpet has been ordered and will be laid after the painting has been completed.

Masonry project: Scaffolding has been built and the demolition of the EIFS has started on the east face of the FLC. Brick has been delivered this week. The mechanical supply and return duct work has been removed and will be replaced after the brick is laid.

Shingle project: Tearing off the old shingles on the south side began on Thursday. New singles will be applied before other tear-off begins. The contractor anticipated the project will be completed in 2-3 days.

Other projects: The south main entrance portico has been repaired and repainted, The steel lintels have been scraped, primed and painted on the north and south entrances. The center wing and office window have been scraped, primed and painted.

We have many other projects that will begin shortly, such as replacing the clouded panels on the stained glass windows on the south side of the Sanctuary. If you have any questions, contact Bill Jesse, who will be available in the Narthex on Sunday.

Governing Board Decision

The Governing Board, based on the recommendation of the Facilities MAT consisting of Brandon Simpson, Facilities Manager, Bill Jesse, Executive Director, and Greg Cushing, congregation member, authorized at a special Board meeting on July 31, the expenditure of up to \$30,000 for the completion of additional smaller projects to be completed this summer. Funds for the projects will be taken from the Long Term Maintenance Fund. The recommended projects are as follows:

 Sand, prime, and paint all steel lintels especially the north and south main entrances. 2) Repair, refinish, and paint the north and south main entrances.
 Replace the windows in the office complex. 4) Replace the clouded windows outside the Sanctuary south stained glass windows. 5) Replace the clouded window in the west peak of the Sanctuary. 6) Scrape and paint the exterior windows of the center wing. 7) Paint the patched wall in the FLC.

Some of these projects have been brought to us by members of the congregation, some have been on a maintenance "wish" list for some time, and some were discovered during the pre-bid meetings for our major projects outlined in the capital campaign information. All of these projects will be completed this summer and early fall.

In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.
