Then King Nebuchadnezzar leaped to his feet in amazement and asked his advisers, "Weren't there three men that we tied up and threw into the fire?" Daniel 3:24

The Dark Days: Daniel in Exile

Exiled? Living in a foreign land away from your family? Being stripped of your name? Forced to change occupations to serve a foreign king? What would you do? Would you roll up in a ball and cry, "I don't deserve this?" Would you aggressively thwart the efforts of those you are forced to live and serve with?

The possible reactions are probably as varied as the individuals who would face similar situations. But the Bible gives us an incredible example of a godly response through Belteshazzar (Daniel), Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. Being stripped of everything familiar, their only stable and unfaltering reality was that the Lord was with them as he was in their homeland. So, they looked up instead of around.

And because they focused on the Lord, there were amazing supernatural happenings interpreting dreams, getting rescued from a furnace and being saved from the malicious jaws of a few lions. And it gets better, their enemies started to see the Lord.

These men who looked up reiterate what God tells through the scripture—seek him, place him at the center of our hearts because "he is worthy, he is with us and will save us."

Cross Talk 2013



Gloria Dei is joining at least 16 churches in Central Iowa in a movement called Cross Talk 2013.

What it is about: In order to make a united statement of proclamation about our resurrected Lord Jesus, we are encouraging Christians in Central Iowa to display a white cross in their front yards from Palm Sunday, March 24 through Easter Sunday, March 31.

The goal: Our culture is more aware of the story of Jesus at Easter than at other times during the year, so we want to demonstrate the presence of Christians in Central Iowa, encourage conversations about the cross of Christ, and to show unity among Christians concerning our resurrected Lord.

The details: Dee Zee Manufacturing will produce (at cost) the durable white steel cross, measuring 40" by 30" for \$11.50. These crosses can then be hammered into the ground.



Then Nebuchadnezzar said, "Praise be to the God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, who has sent his angel and rescued his servants! They trusted in him and defied the king's command and were willing to give up their lives rather than serve or worship any god except their own God.
