The Dark Days: God's Messengers

Before Christmas, we left the people of God in an unpleasant place, they were a divided kingdom far away from God. This week, we will see God's relentless pursuit of calling his people back into a relationship with him through the words (harsh at times) of the prophets.

We will see some of our familiar stories, such as Elijah and Elisha. We will also read the unusual assignment of Hosea and how he was to marry a prostitute named Gomer (interesting name, don't you think?). As the story unfolds, Gomer is unfaithful to Hosea, but this does not sway Hosea's love.

In fact, God tells Hosea to demonstrate his love to her. Hosea schedules a time to be with his wife through one of her unscrupulous "friends." When she enters the room expecting her next customer, she comes face-to-face with her husband. It is then Hosea tells her he loves her and wants her to come back home.

A clear message from God. Unfaithful? He still wants you. Sinning? He still invites you back home. Compromised morals? He extends his hand. Lost? His persistent grace has found you.

As we begin a new year, let's listen to the heart of God in this story. He wants his people to come home. Home—wrapped in his security. Home—swaddled tightly in his love. Since his love is greater than our sordid and ugly past, he is calling us into a relationship with him. So, let's receive the words of the ancient prophets, and dwell in his presence.



Nursery: Infants to age 3. Located on the lower level with access through the doors in the Narthex. The nursery is staffed during all worship services for children ages 3 and under at no cost to the parent.

Cry room: Located in the southwest corner of the Narthex is a room with a full view of the Sanctuary for parents to take their small children.

Communion

For the medical and/or physical needs of members or visitors, nonalcoholic wine will be in the inner circle of each communion tray and will be lighter in color than the regular wine.
