## Take Time to Consider Your Gift

Body building takes time! This is true of the muscles in our physical body and also true of the body of believers. In today's sermon, Pastor Burcham will examine how we can choose to invest our time building up the body of believers by taking time to serve one another. No one is exempt from this call to strengthen the body because scripture tells us that "each one of you should use whatever gift he has received to serve others" I Peter 4:10.

#### **Body Building Time**

Because we all have a gift and a calling to use that gift, Heather Schmitz, a small group leader, asked Pastor Burcham if she and her small group could coordinate a ministry fair.

"We were praying for a way to help our church

in our small group and decided to ask about coordinating a ministry fair," said Heather. "Our intention was to find ways to encourage people to use their God-given gifts within the context of our church. We really wanted to

connect people's gifts to the needs of each individual ministry at Gloria Dei."

In June, Gloria Dei collected \$3,000 in a separate offering for "Preparing Pastors Worldwide," which Pastor Burcham brought to the 63rd LCMS Regular Convention in Houston, Texas. A total of \$455,105 has been collected on a national level, which \$179,219 was contributed during the convention when delegates brought their offerings from their home congregations. Two-thirds of the gifts will support Concordia Seminary in St. Louis, Mo. and Concordia Theological Seminary in Fort Wayne, Ind.; the remaining one-third will support seminaries of LCMS partner churches around the world.

#### Youth



#### **Grief Support Groups**

#### **GriefShare: Thursday, August 23 from 6:30-8 p.m.** GriefShare is a 13-week grief support group for people dealing with the reality and pain of losing a loved one. Each session consists of a video presentation, sharing and prayer time.

#### Stepping Stones: Thursday, Sept. 6 from 6:30-8 p.m.

Stepping Stones, a 6-week grief-support group for young children aimed at providing children a safe place to process their grief. ## Church "Home" Improvements

During the month of August, we will be working on a few remodeling and improvement projects around the building. We wanted to bring to your attention two of the primary projects:

#### Bathrooms

We are in the process of updating the bathrooms in both the middle section as well as in the back of the narthex area. This update will include repainting the bathroom stalls as well as updating the floors, wall coverings, plumbing and countertops as appropriate for each bathroom.

#### **Board Room**

The current board room is located just north of the Gathering Place, outside of the Youth Center. It also has a storage area adjacent to it. The existing board room will be renovated and subdivided into three distinct areas. This will impact a number of things including:

#### • Classroom Space

At both ends of the existing board room, we are going to create two new classrooms with solid walls and doors, which will help provide more rooms for the continued growth of our educational programs.

· Children's Library

In the middle section of the existing board room, we are building a new children's library. This children's library will replace the existing library located in the hallway just to the east of the Youth Center. The new library will provide a more accessible and relaxed environment for the children, a quieter place for them to read and a place to store additional library items.

Board Room

In the space currently housing the children's library, we will construct a wall and create a new board room. Although this room will be smaller than the existing space, it will accommodate the existing board room furniture and will be used for various meetings and adult classes.

These changes will take place over the next several weeks with the goal of completion by the end of August. We are using all of the existing furniture. In addition, most of the labor is from our staff and ministry partners.

We appreciate your patience as a mess may be visible at various times during the week. However, we look forward to the completion of these projects when we will have additional classroom space, a new and vibrant children's library and more up-to-date bathrooms. Thank you for your patience and prayers as we work to make our building meet the needs of our ever-growing congregation.
