"The Lord has placed on my heart a deep desire to be with people," said Rodney. "To be with people in the midst of deep pain and trials, so that I can give an ear to listen and recall God's relentless pursuit for them. I am excited to be with people when they experience profound joy. I am also excited to be with people as they grow

in the knowledge and truth of Jesus, our crucified and risen Lord, and when they get baptized.

"God has always been with me, even when I refused to see him. God has placed me in a community of his people and I feel called to be a Pastor that is present with God's people."

Since Rodney was confirmed at Gloria Dei, his memories at Gloria Dei surface as he recalls: "I remember the van ride into Mexico the first year I went. The van was full and it was crazy hot. Jeremy Meythaler and I were absolutely nuts as we acted out a comic rendition of the Houston ground control scene for more than an hour using sunglasses, seat belts and any other items in the van. Needless to say, we drove most of the team up a wall, with the exception of Jen Peter and some of the guys, who found it funny or at least entertaining."

"I always will remember how Brian and Jen Peter were always there for us, despite how we acted," said Rodney.



Director of Tiny Treasures Preschool Resigns


One known fact about Terry Steinke is her love for children. And since her love extends especially to her grandchildren, she has decided to move closer to them. Terry, who has


