Courage Comes from God

In the fourth component of the GRACE vision, we are encouraged to be courageous in reaching out and sharing the good news of Jesus Christ. A worthy goal: Who doesn't want to be courageous? Who wouldn't want to speak about Jesus Christ? Unfortunately, it doesn't take long in life to realize that being courageous isn't an innate trait to man, we need help.

Take for example, the children of Israel when Moses announced that he would not enter into the promised land. Understandably, they froze in the moment until Moses spoke these words:

"Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the LORD your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you." Deuteronomy 31:6 (NIV)

Despite their fears and perils on every side, their steps to the promised land were to be aligned with the assurance that the Lord was with them. Sound familiar? What happens to us when fear and doubt camp out on our back doorsteps? Do we look at the vastness of the problem or do we see the Lord even in the midst of our trials? What happens when we want to show the love of Jesus even though we may be ridiculed?

David had a similar dilemma when he faced Goliath. The expert Israeli soldiers, including his older brothers, cowered to this man of great stature. Yet, David saw something that others ignored: God was with him.

"The Lord who delivered me from the paw of

the lion and the paw of the bear will deliver me from the hand of this Philistine." I Samuel 17: 36 (NIV)

Courage takes a sharp change of focus; it requires looking at God and not ourselves or our surroundings. In one of my favorite gospel accounts, Peter and the disciples were in tumultuous waters when Jesus walked toward them on the water. Jesus' reaction to their overwhelming fear was, "Take courage! It is I. Do not be afraid."

Those words echo to me today. So many situations in life require us to take courage. Whether it is facing an illness, loving the unlovable, gently correcting a wayward child, standing up for what is right, going against the status quo of society, inviting a co-

worker to church, asking a friend for prayer or speaking the truth in love to those around us; it takes courage. Similar to the lion in the *Wizard of Oz*, my heart often fluctuates with lack of courage and fear to my changing environment. Oftentimes, I think that I am unmatched to face the perilous waters with God's truth and love. Yet, if I stop looking at my surroundings and focus on a God who will never leave me, who sees my dilemmas and is always available, I will be infused with courage.

"Be strong and courageous, and do the work. Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the LORD God, my God, is with you. He will not fail you or forsake you until all the work for the service of the temple of the LORD is finished." 1 Chronicles 28:20 b




