# God's Search and Rescue Requires Us to Shine

Being a beacon is the third component of Gloria Dei's GRACE vision. But what are some practical implications of being a beacon? A few brave souls from Wednesday morning's Bible study answered that question.

A beacon is light, a reflection of your life. At one time or another, we all face illnesses. Yet, within those challenges we can give encouragement to others. – Fred Sturdevant

A beacon becomes a person who you can share your joys and challenges with. – Shirley Kramer

A beacon looks up. When I go traveling, I look up at the crosses on top of churches. It is like that in life, we look up at the cross of Christ. – Steven Baumgarten

A beacon is a light on top of a house. It offers safety. – Morris Grotheer

A beacon is the light that shines out of darkness.

– Louise Grotheer

The dictionary definition of a beacon is: a light-house or other signal for guidance; and a source of light or inspiration. Although the gospels do not specifically use the word beacon, the idea of being a light is a common exhortation for the followers of Jesus Christ.

"You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before men, that

they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven. Matthew 5: 14-16

For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," made his light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ. 2 Corinthians 4:6

Over a century ago, a fierce storm flooded the Des Moines River near Boone, Iowa. Kate Shelley heard a crash in the middle of the night outside her

> home. She searched in the darkness and discovered that a bridge had collapsed, taking a small train and four passengers with it. Realizing that she could not rescue the men by herself and knowing that another train was expected to cross the bridge within

the hour, she crawled across the flooding river on a nearby trestle bridge to the nearest train station. As she burst into the station to warn the agent of the washed-out bridge, the noise of an approaching train could be faintly heard. The agent immediately ran out in the storm with a red light to halt the advancing train.

Kate and the agent were beacons to their community in the midst of a disaster. It took a cooperative effort of both of them to warn the approaching train and then to rescue the men in the wreck.

Likewise, God has called us to a collaborative effort to shine as lights, to actively help our neighbors when their bridges crash and impeding troubles are approaching, to be a safe harbor in the midst of a storm and to extend a warm hand to those hurting and drowning.


