## His sacrifice and mediation

At this, some of his disciples said to one another, "What does he mean by saying, 'In a little while you will see me no more, and then after a little while you will see me,' and 'Because I am going to the Father'?" They kept asking, "What does he mean by 'a little



while'? We don't understand what he is saying." John 16:17-18

Today we land in the midst of a developing controversy in Jerusalem as the disciples wrestle with Jesus' words. They begin to banter among themselves: What is Jesus actually saying? We won't see him? And then we will see him? Makes no sense. Besides, define in real time, what a little while is? Is it a month, a day or tomorrow?

Jesus understood their confusion. He further explained the reason behind his impending death—he was to give his life as a sacrifice, so that he could appear in God's presence for them—all the time and in every situation throughout eternity.

The book of Hebrews gives us more insight into what this entails. In the Old Testament priests interceded for the people, but the High Priest would go into the Holy of Holies and be in the presence of God to offer sacrifices for the people. Jesus is our High Priest, who offered his own body, obtaining eternal redemption for mankind. His sacrifice was once and for all, and he now intercedes to the Father for us. His perfect sacrifice ushers us into direct access to the Father. A great place to be, wouldn't you agree?

In today's message, we will further examine how Jesus mediates for us as a High Priest and how it applies to our lives.

## Multi-site update

This week at the end of each worship service, Pastor Burcham will share what it means to be a multi-site congregation and how that would look at Gloria Dei as we seek to bring Jesus to people for the first time and for a lifetime. It is our prayer that his talk will help all of us gain a glimpse into the specific aspects of multi-site ministry. #### Other Important Items

#### Communion

## **Weekly Bible Reading**

#### Hebrews 9:24-28 (NIV)

For Christ did not enter a man-made sanctuary that was only a copy of the true one; he entered heaven itself, now to appear for us in God's presence. Nor did he enter heaven to offer himself again and again, the way the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood that is not his own. Then Christ would have had to suffer many times since the creation of the world. But now he has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of himself. Just as man is destined to die once, and after that to face judgment, so Christ was sacrificed once to take away the sins of many people; and he will appear a second time, not to bear sin, but to bring salvation to those who are waiting for him.
