The heart behind the new worship service

In recent weeks, we have announced plans to launch a new casual contemporary service on Sunday, Oct. 9 at 9 a.m. in the Family Life Center. It will be similar to Saturday evening Northwind service, offering a balance of high-energy and reflective worship in the casual atmosphere of the Family Life Center. The truths of God's Word will be received through the video format from Saturday night's service with a pastor and a worship assistant to help us.

With all those specific facts made known, there is one vital component missing—the heart behind it all. Therefore, to the best of my ability, I will convey what is deep within my soul as we prepare for this new worship service.

We recognized a gap in the services that we offer at Gloria Dei. In our culture, the 9 a.m. time slot seems to be a prime moment for people to attend a corporate worship gathering before all the activities of the day and week begin. It is our desire to supplement families with the necessary tools to help them connect to God in a timeframe that enhances their family schedule. We want to help them not only on Sunday, but throughout the week as they raise their families. We believe we can help facilitate this growth through a large-group worship and small-group experience in an informal environment.

Another important aspect of the new service is the element of casual contemporary. I believe it reflects God's heart in Romans 5:8: "While we were yet sinners Christ died for us." God's love calls us to come as we are—no clean up, no change of lifestyle, no economic floor or ceiling requirements—just a call to come as we are. We are all sinners (you, me, our neighbors and our co-workers), who need to be changed by the transforming power of Jesus.

With the belief that we needed to reach our neighbors and provide another worship opportunity for our members, we launched a contemporary Saturday evening service in the Family Life Center five years ago. With the help of missionaries, prayers and support from the congregation, we have been thrilled to see this worship service grow not only in numbers, but also in relationships. Similarly, we believe this new service will provide another worship opportunity that will draw in our neighbors and help our members. *(continue on page 2)*

For the medical and/or physical needs of members or visitors, nonalcoholic wine will be in the inner circle of each communion tray and will be lighter in color than the regular wine. In addition, gluten-free wafers are available, please alert the elders before the service if possible.
