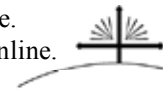

What trust can lead to

In today's destination, we continue to observe God's chosen people, the Israelites. They are now out of Egypt, into what is commonly referred to as the wilderness. In their recent history, they would have seen God's power manifested in a variety of larger-than-life ways. From the unusual plagues to the parting of the Red Sea, they have certainly seen God's power at work. In fact, Exodus 14:30 records that "when the people of Israel saw the mighty power that the Lord had unleashed against the Egyptians, they were filled with awe."

Of course, God's love continued in the wilderness by providing manna, water and quail for them to eat along with a host of other provisions, such as giving them spiritual guidance, the Ten Commandments, and a holy sanctuary, the Tabernacle. God wanted to be with his people and he wanted his people to trust him.

He showed you these things so you would know that the Lord is God and there is no other.
Deuteronomy 4:35

By all accounts, it seems that they had it made, they were out of Egypt, heading toward the Promised Land. So, then what happened that made them want to return to Egypt? Did they think God couldn't back up his promises? Did they think God had left them? What were they thinking?

Enter—hardships. Enter—an unfamiliar location. Enter—rough times. Enter—things not going to plan. Enter—things taking longer than anticipated. Enter—not trusting in God. Even with all their recent history in seeing God's power, once they hit adverse circumstances, they melted. They perceived their circumstances as larger than their God and as a result, they trusted in their old familiar ways and forgot about the ways of God.

However, Israel's less-than-honorable response did not stop God. He pardoned their distrust, but with an understanding that they would not enter into the Promised Land. There was an addendum to God's ruling—only Caleb, Joshua and Israelites' children would set their feet in the Promised Land. Not even Moses was permitted to enter the Promised Land.

So, today as we walk through the wilderness with the Israelites, we are mournful of their untrusting ways, but are cognizant of the benefits of trusting the God who only wants the best for his people.

During the forty years that I led you through the desert, your clothes did not wear out, nor did the sandals on your feet. You ate no bread and drank no wine or other fermented drink. I did this so that you might know that I am the Lord your God. Deuteronomy 29:5-6

Help rewrite the story for a fatherless youth – become a mentor

A few months ago, Pastor Phillips believed that God was nudging him to help the community more, specifically in the area of helping youth. After much prayer, and exploring a few options, he was excited to discover The Mentoring Project in central Iowa.

What is The Mentoring Project? The Mentoring Project’s goal is to reach out to fatherless youth to show Christ’s love, as well as to eliminate the “waiting list” for mentors many communities face. It is a 501(c)(3) non profit based out of Portland, Oregon. Locally, it is a collaboration between the Waukee Family YMCA, Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Iowa, and the local church community, which now includes Gloria Dei.



Why is “fatherlessness” a big deal? There are many reasons biblically why it is important that Christians look to fill this void. However, here are some statistics that speak to the impact “fatherlessness” has on youth.

- 70% of all youth in prisons are from fatherless homes
- 63% of youth suicides are from fatherless homes
- 71% of teenage pregnancies are from fatherless homes
- 75% of drug abusers are from fatherless homes
- 90% of homeless are from fatherless homes

What is the format and time requirement for being a mentor? Mentors will be asked to build relationships through one-on-one time with youth at least one hour per week, committing to at least one year of service. Mentoring oftentimes will happen in schools or at the YMCA. As the relationship grows, opportunities to meet outside of the school or YMCA will be acceptable.

How do I get started? Attend a training on Saturday, March 5 from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Waukee Family YMCA. Please contact Pastor Phillips at tphillips@gloriadeionline.com for more information. To register for the training, contact Eric Kress at eric.kress@dmymca.org or 868-0502 by Feb. 26.

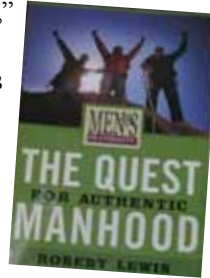

Communion

Communion is offered on the first and third Sundays of each month during the services in the Sanctuary and the second and fourth Saturdays and Sundays during the services in the Family Life Center.

A note to our guests and visitors: The Lord's Supper is celebrated at Gloria Dei in the belief and with the confession that this Sacrament is the very body and blood of Christ (The Doctrine of the Real Presence) which is received with the bread and the wine for us to eat and drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our faith. Our Lord invites to his table those who trust his words, repent of all sin, and seek to forgive and love as He forgives and loves us. If you agree with our beliefs regarding the nature and meaning of this Sacrament and desire to commune with us, you are welcome! For the medical and/or physical needs of members or visitors, non-alcoholic wine will be in the inner circle of each communion tray and will be lighter in color than the regular wine. In addition, gluten-free wafers are available, please alert the elders before the service if possible.

Weekly Bible Reading

Deuteronomy 29:1-6 (NIV)

These are the terms of the covenant the LORD commanded Moses to make with the Israelites in Moab, in addition to the covenant he had made with them at Horeb. Moses summoned all the Israelites and said to them: Your eyes have seen all that the LORD did in Egypt to Pharaoh, to all his officials and to all his land. With your own eyes you saw those great trials, those miraculous signs and great wonders. But to this day the LORD has not given you a mind that understands or eyes that see or ears that hear. During the forty years that I led you through the desert, your clothes did not wear out, nor did the sandals on your feet. You ate no bread and drank no wine or other fermented drink. I did this so that you might know that I am the LORD your God.
