Protection can be seen during bleak times

This weekend we land in the midst of a familiar story—Joseph and his brothers. As you may recall, Joseph's brothers connived against him and for 20 shekels of silver sold him to the Ishmaelites.

To make matters worse, the brothers covered up their dastardly act by dipping Joseph's robe in the blood of a slaughtered goat before presenting the brutal "facts" of Joseph's demise to their father, Jacob. Being over-

whelmed by grief, Jacob cries out "in mourning will I go down to the grave to my son."

Two innocent victims emerge from the hands of these jealous brothers. What is a brother or father to do when life deals an unfair hand? Did questions arise in their minds? Why me Lord? What have I done to deserve this treatment? Where are you, Lord?

We know from scripture that God is present even when we walk through the darkest valley. But if you have ever been in a murky situation in life, it may take some time to convince your mind that God has not left your side and has your best interest at heart.

According to history books, Corrie Ten Boom found herself in a bleak and unfair situation. In 1940, the Ten Boom's house was used as a hiding place for refugees trying to seek shelter from the hideous claws of the Nazis. Four years later, an informant notified the authorities, which resulted in the entire Ten Boom family being incarcerated. Ten days after their capture, her father died. A few months later, Corrie witnessed the death of her sister, Betsie, who declared these words before she died, "There is no pit so deep that God's love is not deeper still."

Similar words are found in Psalms.

He brought me out into a spacious place; he rescued me because he delighted in me. Psalm 18:19

You are my hiding place; you will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance. Psalm 32:7

Do not withhold your mercy from me, Lord; may your love and faithfulness always protect me. Psalm 40:11

The Bible makes it clear that no matter what situation we find ourselves in, God is bigger than the situation; his protection is in place even if we do not visibly see it. Today, we will further learn how Joseph rose above his bleak situation to declare God's protection and faithfulness:

You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of lives. Genesis 50:20

We offer the following guidelines to these two often-asked questions:

When is it appropriate to leave and re-enter the Sanctuary during worship?

If you find it necessary to leave during a worship service, it is better not to return to your seat during the quieter times of the service, such as the confession and absolution, special choir music, the Scripture readings, the prayers and the benediction. Wait for a time for congregational singing to re-enter the service. If you must leave and re-enter during the sermon, please be considerate to those worshipping with you.

Absolutely yes! We encourage the entire family to worship together. However, if your children become a distraction to those worshipping around you, please excuse yourself and go to the cry room, located outside the Sanctuary. The cry room is equipped with comfortable seats and toys for you and your child to enjoy while still being able to listen and participate in worship.

For the medical and/or physical needs of members or visitors, non-alcoholic wine will be in the inner circle of each communion tray and will be lighter in color than the regular wine. In addition, gluten-free wafers are available, please alert the elders before the service if possible.
