manifested through many signs and wonders. As a result, they humbly lived the upside-down teachings of Jesus and then boldly proclaimed the Gospel in a culture which was plagued with a strong anti-Jesus sentiment.

June 4-5 - Preparation

The disciples were busy preparing their minds through prayer and spending time in God's Word in Jerusalem while waiting to receive the Holy Spirit. Can we learn something from their preparation? Scripture: Acts 1:12-26 and Luke 24:36-53

June 11-12 - Passion

The passion of the first century church is evident by how they lived, declared the Gospel and prayed. Imagine an entire room shaking after prayer. Scripture: Acts 4:23-31 and Luke 19:45-48

June 18-19 - Purpose

Jesus clearly instructs us to proclaim his name to all people. If our true purpose is to bring Jesus Christ to people for the first time and a lifetime, should our lives more accurately reflect his purpose? Scripture: Acts 5:17-42 and Luke 24:36-49

June 25-26 - Power

God gave the Apostles the Holy Spirit. Is it any wonder that the first-century Christian church became the talk of the day when people saw many signs and wonders from a powerful and magnificent God. God's power did not die with the Apostles, Scripture states he desires to equip each of us with his Holy Spirit. Scripture: Acts 1:4-8, 2:1-12 and Luke 24:46-53


Annual meeting


2011 Dining Together

Gloria Dei has five services over the weekend with an average of 1,000 people coming through the door. We stress relationships are important, but it can be very difficult to get to know people. Well, now is your chance to try something new. A new ministry initiative, Dining Together, begins June 24-26 for anyone interested in meeting new people at Gloria Dei by simply going out to dinner. Our hope is you will meet new people and enjoy each other's company.

How does "Dining Together" work?

There will be Dining Together sign-up sheets at the Welcome Center in the narthex. The deadline for signing up is June 19 for the June 24-26 outings. You will have the option to sign up for a multi-generational group or an adult group.

After the sign-up deadline has passed, participants will be divided into groups of six to eight people. A group leader will contact the other participants to assist in deciding when to meet and if the group will meet in a restaurant or in someone's home. You can choose to dine together for breakfast, lunch or dinner.

In addition, gluten-free wafers are available, please alert the elders before the service if possible.

Weekly Bible reading - Luke 24:36-39 and 44-49 (NIV)

While they were still talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." They were startled and frightened, thinking they saw a ghost. He said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts rise in your minds? Look at my hands and my feet. It is I myself!
