
Rebounding from a Loss

Multi-site ministry updates

Town Hall meetings: Town Hall meetings were conducted last week where individuals asked questions concerning the identification of the Hickman site. This is the first step into multi-site ministry, which we believe will help us fulfill our mission of bringing Jesus Christ to people for the first time and for a lifetime. Among the great questions asked, a few questions surfaced:

Why are we on the fast track to vote on purchasing the Hickman building? Once we identified that the Hickman building would serve us presently and in the future, we talked to the owner, who gave us until the end of December to purchase the Hickman building for \$950,000; down from the asking price of \$1.8 million. According to our constitution, a vote is required before we can purchase property, thus the congregational vote in mid-December.

Will the Hickman site be a full functioning campus on the weekends? Yes, the Hickman campus will hold full worship services, Grace Place, Castaway, the Point and adult Bible studies during the weekend.

What will be offered on Wednesday evenings at the Hickman campus? All Wednesday youth educational times (grades 6-12) will be held at the Hickman campus.

What will the worship space look like? There are no finalized drawings at this point, but we do know that it will be contemporary. We also know that we will use it as a video recording studio, so the lighting and sound will be conducive for those purposes.

What's Next? The Governing Board, and the four Ministry Action Teams are working together to complete the comprehensive plan to be brought to the congregation during the following Cottage meetings:

Weekly Bible reading - 1 Corinthians 15:1-11 (NIV)

Now, brothers, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain. For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Peter, and then to the Twelve. After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep. Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles, and last of all he appeared to me also, as to one abnormally born. For I am the least of the apostles and do not even deserve to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me was not without effect. No, I worked harder than all of them—yet not I, but the grace of God that was with me. Whether, then, it was I or they, this is what we preach, and this is what you believed.
