God's messenger

Then Haggai, the Lord's messenger, gave this message of the Lord to the people: "I am with you," declares the Lord." Haggai 1:13

A New Day is Coming: The Return Home

In this chapter, we see God's upper story clearly defined—he wants his people to return to Jerusalem, so he can show his love, faithfulness and glory to them as well as to the world. Not only does he promise that the new temple "will be greater than the glory of the former house," but their city streets will be "filled with boys and girls playing."

We also see God's mighty work come into fruition by a few unlikely characters and circumstances. For example, the pagan king, Cyrus of Persia, was instrumental in moving God's people (approximately 50,000) to Jerusalem to rebuild the temple. Or how about another pagan king, who issued an order to search the royal archives for the evidence of the original mandate? Or the two prophets, Haggai and Zechariah, who God sent to encourage his people?

We clearly see God, don't we? But we also see the spirals of the men and women involved in the lower story. At times they faithfully responded to God, but then lived in complacency, followed by discouragement, which resulted in being lost for 16 years before again responding to God's directives and promises.

There's a lot happening in this chapter, and it would be easy to get lost in the details; however, today's message should help us to focus on some of the important truths found in this chapter.

An Artist Continues His Handiwork

Israel Lopez, a local artist, continues to use his artistic talents at Gloria Dei in illustrating each

chapter of "The Story" onto his ceramic canvas—a 10.5 inch black plate.

"To be honest, I have never read the entire Bible, so this is the first time in

my life that I am reading it and I am really enjoying it," says Israel. Israel was trained to be a landscape painter under the tutelage of his father and uncle while growing up in Mazatlan, Mexico. He admits that this project has stretched him to be flexible because it requires more abstract

and symbolic images.

"These plates are cool. I never thought I'd be painting about the Bible because for years I rejected God and thought the Bible was boring,"

says Israel. "And now look at me, I even look up words from the reading if I do not understand them."

There are other surprises and blessings in Israel's life, Krystle, Israel's wife, and their two children, Kaylee, 3, and Ethan, 2, are now embracing many of the ministries at Gloria Dei. In fact, Israel smiles when he shares how Krystle now insists that their family "prays before they eat."

Another major shift in Israel is a deep desire to give back to the church and to the community. "I used to do everything for money, but there is a time that you want to give, and this is the time," says Israel.

Israel will be in the Narthex on Sunday to share his story and to give more details concerning each plate. At the end of the series in April, these plates will be auctioned off and the proceeds will be given to a mission project. So stop by to enjoy his art and story.



Communion is offered on the first and third Sundays of each month during the services in the Sanctuary and the second and fourth Saturdays and Sundays during the services in the Family Life Center.

A note to our guests and visitors: The Lord's Supper is celebrated at Gloria Dei in the belief and with the confession that this Sacrament is the very body and blood of Christ (The Doctrine of the Real Presence) which is received with the bread and the wine for us to eat and drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our faith. Our Lord invites to his table those who trust his words, repent of all sin, and seek to forgive and love as He forgives and loves us. If you agree with our beliefs regarding the nature and meaning of this Sacrament and desire to commune with us, you are welcome! For the medical and/or physical needs of members or visitors, non-alcoholic wine will be in the inner circle of each communion tray and will be lighter in color than the regular wine. In addition, gluten-free wafers are available, please alert the elders before the service if possible.
