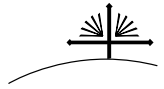

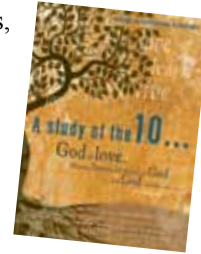

A Study of the 10...

Bringing Jesus Christ to people for the first time and for a lifetime.

As we dive into an in-depth look at the Ten Commandments, we need to set the stage. The Israelites under Moses' leadership had been miraculously freed from Egypt where they lived for four hundred years. Think about it! All they would have ever known was slavery. Their grandparents, great grandparents, and three other generations of grandparents would have lived under Egyptian rule. Every conceivable memory would have centered around slavery. Now, for two months, they have traveled in an unknown environment without all the familiarity of life, their home, schedule, food and culture. It is in this transitional framework that God begins a work by asking Moses to tell the Israelites these words:



"You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself. Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession." Exodus 19:4-5a

The story rapidly progresses when the Israelites responded to Moses by saying, "We will do everything the Lord has said." God then spoke the words that are now referred to as the Ten Commandments. Today's message will look into the reasons why God gave his people clear-cut commandments two months after their freedom from Egypt. We will also see his motive behind it all—his deep and constant love for them.

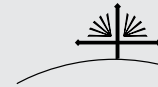

Communion

Communion is offered on the first and third Sundays of each month during the services in the Sanctuary and the second and fourth Saturdays and Sundays during the services in the Family Life Center.

A note to our guests and visitors: The Lord's Supper is celebrated at Gloria Dei in the belief and with the confession that this Sacrament is the very body and blood of Christ (The Doctrine of the Real Presence) which is received with the bread and the wine for us to eat and drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our faith. Our Lord invites to his table those who trust his words, repent of all sin, and seek to forgive and love as He forgives and loves us. If you agree with our beliefs regarding the nature and meaning of this Sacrament and desire to commune with us, you are welcome! For the medical and/or physical needs of members or visitors, non-alcoholic wine will be in the inner circle of each communion tray and will be lighter in color than the regular wine. In addition, gluten-free wafers are available, please alert the elders before the service if possible.

This Week's Bible Reading

Exodus 19:9, 16-20; 20:1-2 (NIV)

The LORD said to Moses, "I am going to come to you in a dense cloud, so that the people will hear me speaking with you and will always put their trust in you." Then Moses told the LORD what the people had said.

On the morning of the third day there was thunder and lightning, with a thick cloud over the mountain, and a very loud trumpet blast. Everyone in the camp trembled. Then Moses led the people out of the camp to meet with God, and they stood at the foot of the mountain. Mount Sinai was covered with smoke, because the LORD descended on it in fire. The smoke billowed up from it like smoke from a furnace, the whole mountain trembled violently, and the sound of the trumpet grew louder and louder. Then Moses spoke and the voice of God answered him.

The LORD descended to the top of Mount Sinai and called Moses to the top of the mountain. So Moses went up.

And God spoke all these words: "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery."
