The Faith of Mary

Teenagers are invincible! Just ask them; they know the risks of driving too fast—accidents won't happen to them. For the most part, teenagers believe the improbable, take risks that we would never dream of and fervently pursue their passions. Their view of the world is not as tainted as that of adults, for they have not been

disappointed or seen the worst side of people. Maybe that is why I like teens; they still believe they can revolutionize the world; no common-sense talk will change their mind. Something deep inside of them says anything can happen.

I know what you are thinking: you would certainly believe if you had a conversation with a real angel. But is that true? In the Old Testament, the children of Israel were surrounded by a pillar of a cloud during the day and a pillar of fire at night. Pretty dramatic in my book, yet even with God's presence always before them, they grumbled and their faith fluctuated. Even in our lives,

how quickly we forget the daily

miracles: when our health is restored, a job offer is made, or relationships are restored. We see God in our lives, but like the children of Israel, when another challenge arises, we question his abilities.

I wonder if that is why God chose Mary, a teenager, to give birth to the son of God. After all, who else would believe the angel's words: "You will be with child and give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus." Mary did. It was not important for her to understand everything, although she was curious about the technicality of having a child as a virgin. But after the angel answered her question, she simply stated, "I am the Lord's servant; may it be to me as you have said."

Now that is faith! No list of questions, concerns or apprehensions—Mary knew God would be faithful and take care of her. After all, she was the Lord's servant. Who else but an invincible, believing, passionate teenager could have such faith?

Hebrews 11:1 states, "Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see." It is the faith that God has poured out into our hearts that enables us to believe the impossible, have strength for the tough times and know that God will not let us down. Mary had that kind of faith. She became the Lord's servant and gave birth to the Son of God by believing in God's ability.

Our faith is in a God who keeps his promises, a God who loved us so much that he came, lived among us and died in our place. Our faith is in a God that will never leave us nor forsake us.

Our God is such a God that we are invincible! With him all things are possible. Maybe it is time for us to have the faith, belief, trust and even the confidence of a teenager.




