



One woman's reflections on Women's Bible Connections

When I was given a Gerbera Daisy at the end of this summer, I was told of an exciting new endeavor that would bring lots of women together, who were looking for Christian fellowship. This gathering would allow us to relax and unwind while lending us the opportunity to attend one of several different Bible studies and courses that would be offered.

At first I was a little hesitant, thinking a full fledged Bible study wasn't for me right now, as I didn't have time for a lot of "homework." However, as I learned more about this opportunity, I could feel God gently guiding me to step out and make a commitment to feed my soul. Along with my friend, together we made a commitment to attend "Focus on the Family's, The Truth Project." This is a wonderful series of thought provoking videos that encourage discussion within the group about society's views on many things and the age-old question of our ultimate purpose.

I suddenly found myself looking forward to Monday nights with "the girls" and held that as my sacred time to get re-energized and challenge myself to reestablish my worldview as a Christian and to get to know those in my group a little better. And this could all be enjoyed without needing to do any homework, because this particular course was strictly video/discussion based.

My Mondays with "the girls" delivered thought provoking points that I was able to weave into work discussions when the opportunity presented itself. I learned that I have a common bond with a lot of women in my group, with similar societal concerns about raising children with Christian values, in a sometimes not so Christian world. I learned that each of us has a voice and it's up to us to speak out for what is right and not wait for someone else to do it. I learned that sometimes I have to step out in faith, even when it's not the easy thing to do.

Weekends at Gloria Dei Nursery

Cry room

Families worship together

Grace Place - preschool and elementary children
