## China Update

For the next several weeks, there will be an opportunity to stop in the narthex between services to hear about the work in China and Tibet.

Please take a moment to stop and see pictures of the Christian church, which was built in a remote mountain village with funds from Gloria Dei. The opportunity to build this church was made possible with more than five years of humanitarian support in the region. The Gospel has been brought to life through enhanced living conditions, educational opportunities, and medical and dental clinics.

Partnering with the Shining City Foundation (SCF), we continue to support priority needs in the area. In September, several members of Gloria Dei had the opportunity to establish a relationship with the Lucky Star Orphanage School in Lhasa, Tibet. There are about 50 children in this school, who continue to need basic necessities such as bedding and food provisions. A mattress and quilt for a child can be provided for \$20, and a week-long supply of rice, wheat, and cooking oil for all 50 students costs only \$50. There is no administrative cost involved, so every dollar contributed goes to project support.

For every contribution of \$20 to support the current needs of the Lucky Star Orphanage, a 14-month calendar that showcases the spectacular beauty of remote China will be given out. The photos are by our lead contact in the area, who is also an award-winning photographer.





## **Weekends at Gloria Dei** Nursery

**Infants to age 3**. Located on the lower level, access is through the doors in the Narthex. The nursery is staffed during all worship services for children ages 3 and under at no cost to the parent.

#### **Cry Room**

Located in the southeast corner of the Narthex is a room for parents to take their small children to when they are upset or crying. This room allows full view of the Sanctuary and has full audio to hear the service.

#### **Families Worship Together**

With the exception of the 7:45 a.m. service, the first twenty minutes of each worship service is designed for families to worship together. At that point in the service, children and youth will be invited to join their peers in an educational time specifically for them as outlined below.

#### **Grace Place - Preschool and Elementary Children**

We offer Grace Place, our weekend educational time, for children ages 3 to fifth grade at three different times: Saturday from 5:50-6:30 p.m.; Sunday from 9:20-10 a.m.; and Sunday from 10:50-11:30 a.m. Children will be invited from worship to attend Grace Place. They will gather outside of worship and leaders will escort them to their classrooms.

#### Castaway - Youth

For our junior high youth in grades 6-8, we have a high-energy educational time, Castaway, in the Youth Center on Sundays at 9:20 and 10:50 a.m.

#### Senior High and Adults

Our senior high youth in grades 9-12 are invited to a study on Sundays from 9-10 a.m. in rooms 134-38.

Adults are invited to join us for an in-depth journey using materials from the Lifelight series in rooms 131-33 from 9:20-10:20 a.m, or a study that parallels the new sermon series from 10:20-11:20 a.m. in rooms 135-37.
