Encounter Jesus

"Name a famous person you have met," was the question posed in my small group. While most of us had to scramble, my friend blurted out that she met Caroline Kennedy while in college. Although exciting for a moment, she said that encounter had a minimal impact on her life. The conversation then developed into a reflection of the people who have deeply influenced our lives. That list became longer. Ordinary people, such as sisters, brothers, fathers, mothers and husbands appeared on our top-ten list. We agreed that these relationships have deeply rooted and molded us. As we reminisced about the power of these relationships, we also noted that these are minimal compared to our relationship with Jesus Christ. He not only deeply impacted us, but he completely rearranged our lives and moved us from darkness into light.

One encounter with Jesus has lasting impact. Take Paul, in the New Testament, for example. While strolling down the road with his pharisaical agenda of persecuting the church, he encountered Jesus. The permanent impact of that meeting is reflected in Philippians 3:8:

What is more, I consider everything a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things.

All of Paul's powerful influences, background, education and credentials were nothing compared to the greatness of knowing Christ Jesus, his Lord. The gospels are rich with stories of people meeting Jesus. How about the two on the road to Emmaus? Weren't they engrossed with their grave observations of Jesus' crucifixion when Jesus approached them? Afterwards, they gleefully commented, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with

us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?" Luke 24:32.

How about the disciples' encounters with the risen Jesus? Their fearful and anxious state soon changed into joy when Jesus appeared to them while they were eating broiled fish around a fire.

Although we do not have the time to view all accounts in which people's lives were unexpectedly changed by an encounter with Jesus, Pastor Burcham will examine six of them through a series of messages entitled, "Encounter Jesus." These men and women were ordinary people, like us, but who met an extraordinary Lord who completely turned their lives around. We will examine the dynamics of Nicodemus, the rich man, the woman at the well, the women caught in adultery, Martha, the inhabitants of Jerusalem and Thomas. Each one was marked with a different background and personality, not to mention the wide variety of personal relationships that molded them throughout their lives. Yet a common thread emerged that changed their lives—an encounter with the Savior of mankind, Jesus Christ.

Since Jesus is the same yesterday, today and tomorrow, we can expect our lives will be forever changed by him.






