Report from Uganda

Since we are committed to living out our vision of being courageous in outreach, we continue to partner with the Lutheran Church Missions in Uganda (LCMU) by sending financial support and donated items and sponsoring a seminary student. We are excited as we build relationships with our fellow believers across the world.

Seminary Student

Last year, we decided to fund a scholarship for the education of Waako Yeko, a 33-year-old seminary student from Uganda. Waako

is passionate about the opportunity to gain knowledge that will match his desire to share God's love and grace. In 1995, Waako studied to become an evangelist and was commissioned to share the Word as an active evangelist in 1998. Last February, he began his three-year journey at the seminary in South Africa. After he graduates, he plans to serve the churches in Uganda.

One God Story

Recently, we heard about God's provision for Waako.

Pastor Burcham received an e-mail from our contact in Uganda, Pastor Charles, who requested assistance in purchasing a motorcycle

for Waako to travel to congregations (a basic means of transportation in Uganda). Meanwhile, an anonymous Gloria Dei member contacted Pastor Burcham about a gift to the ministry, which totaled the exact money needed to purchase the motorcycle. Even though the givers had no idea of the need across the ocean, they were moved to donate the money. God used the donation

to bless Waako and the churches that he ministers to. God is a God who provides even across the world. God is good and greatly to be praised!

Members of the Honduras mission team departed for their trip on Friday. They will return Saturday, June 28.

They have been busy packing quilts, tools, prescription glasses and other medical supplies.

Among those wrapping up some of the last details was Norma Rohn.

Norma and Connie Cook headed up a quilting class where 17 individuals from ages 11 to 60 sewed 57 quilts that will be given to the people of Honduras.

“It is awesome to see God’s hand in this trip,” said Norma. “It is not just the team, but it’s the entire church that has helped to make this trip happen. They have supported the work so much by giving financially, donating personal items, tools and blankets, and by expressing kind and encouraging words.”

Norma is not new to the mission field; she has traveled to Russia, Alaska, China and Mexico, but is excited to go for the first time with Gloria Dei.

“I wanted to be a part of a mission team from Gloria Dei,” said Norma. “It is so exciting to see everything come together. I am looking forward to going on an adventure to experience what God can and will do.”

Norma is equally excited because of the support from her family and friends. In preparation for the trip, the team was asked to write support letters for financial assistance. Norma was so excited when her son responded by giving enough money to help fund several cement floors for local houses. When Norma told him about how his money could be used, he was amazed that cement floors could be purchased for only \$80, and yet most houses still do not have them.

Weekends at Gloria Dei

Nursery

Infants to age 3. Located on the lower level, access is through the doors in the narthex. The nursery is staffed during all worship services for children ages 3 and under at no cost to the parent.

Cry room

Located in the southeast corner of the narthex is a room for parents to take their small children when they are upset or crying. This room allows full view of the sanctuary and has full audio to hear the service.

Families worship together

Communion

Communion is offered on the first and third Sundays of each month during the services in the Sanctuary and the second and fourth Saturdays during the services in the Family Life Center.

A note to our guests and visitors: The Lord's Supper is celebrated at Gloria Dei in the belief and with the confession that this Sacrament is the very body and blood of Christ (The Doctrine of the Real Presence) which is received with the bread and the wine for us to eat and drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our faith. Our Lord invites to his table those who trust his words, repent of all sin, and seek to forgive and love as He forgives and loves us. If you agree with our beliefs regarding the nature and meaning of this Sacrament and desire to commune with us, you are welcome! For the medical and/or physical needs of members or visitors, non-alcoholic wine will be in the inner circle of each communion tray and will be lighter in color than the regular wine.
