### **Details and Qualifications**

Voting stations will be located in rooms 130 and 132. Members will sign in and receive a paper ballot. The completed ballot will be placed in a secured container. Ballots will be counted immediately following the close of voting on Sunday, March 2, 2008.

In order for the Strategic Plan to be accepted by the congregation, the vote will require that 2/3 of those who voted will have voted in favor of the Strategic Plan.



**Voter Ballot March 2008** 

This voter ballot is for a voting member of Gloria Dei Lutheran Church to express their approval or non-approval of Gloria Dei's Strategic Plan, dated February 2008. Indicate your vote at the bottom of this page.

To pass, this vote requires that 2/3 of those who voted will have voted in favor of the Strategic Plan.

The direction provided by the congregation will be either "YES"- approve for implementation the Strategic Plan, or "NO" - non-approval of the Strategic Plan.

A "Yes" vote indicates your approval of the Strategic Plan and allows the Gloria Dei Governing Board to move forward with implementation of the Strategic Plan. The Strategic Plan calls for relocation of the congregation to another site. Further congregational approvals are needed for the purchase of land, sale of the existing church property, and church operating budget.

A "No" vote indicates your non-approval of the Strategic Plan and will require the Gloria Dei Governing Board to reevaluate the Strategic Plan for Gloria Dei Lutheran Church. A revised strategic plan would be developed and presented to the congregation for voter approval.

For the last several years, members of Gloria Dei have been called to bring Jesus Christ to the remote parts of China, specifically to the Yunnan Providence and Tibet, a region known for its isolation due to the vast Himala-yan mountains. Its freezing winters and dry summers make the inhabitants fight for daily survival. Its main religion is Tibetan Buddhism, which believes in reincarnation and the steps to enlightenment. A common practice of their religion is to offer gifts to statues as a payment for eternal life.

Shining City Foundation, a private organization formed in 2001 by a few members from Gloria Dei, has been committed to enhancing the lives of those in the impover-ished region by providing:

- · Improved medical and dental accessibility
- Enhancements at an ethnic orphanage for over 300 children
- Portable solar electric generators (120 units)
- Improvements at primary school
- Ongoing monthly scholarship support to students
- Initial support of second orphanage in Tibet

### Weekends at Gloria Dei

### **Nursery**

Infants to age 3. Located on the lower level, access is through the doors in the narthex. The nursery is staffed during all worship services for children ages 3 and under at no cost to the parent.

#### **Cry room**

Located in the southeast corner of the narthex is a room for parents to take their small children to when they are upset or crying. This room allows full view of the sanctuary and has full audio to hear the service.

### **Families worship together**

With the exception of the 7:45 a.m. service, the first 20 minutes of each worship service is designed for families to worship together. At that point in the service, children and youth will be invited to join their peers in an educational time specifically for them as outlined below.

#### Grace Place - preschool and elementary children

We offer Grace Place, our weekend educational time, for children ages 3 to fifth grade at three different times: Saturday from 5:50-6:30 p.m.; Sunday from 9:20-10 a.m.; and Sunday from 10:50-11:30 a.m. Children will be invited from worship to attend Grace Place. They will gather outside of worship and leaders will escort them to their classrooms.

#### Castaway - youth

For our junior high youth in grades 6-8, we have a high-energy educational time, Castaway, in the Youth Center on Sundays at 9:20 and 10:50 a.m.

#### Senior high and adults

Our senior high youth in grades 9-12 are invited to a study on Sundays from 9-10 a.m. in rooms 134-38. Adults are invited to join us for an in-depth journey using materials from the Lifelight series in rooms 131-33 from 9:20-10:20 a.m.
