## A Time to Remember

Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. Psalm 100:4

Even though Thanksgiving was first celebrated in 1621, it was nationally recognized by President Washington in 1789 when he issued a Proclamation for citizens to "unite in rendering unto him our sincere and humble thanks." In 1863, Abraham Lincoln declared Thanksgiving as a Federal holiday and invited all the citizens of the United States to "set apart and observe the last Thursday of November next, as a day of Thanksgiving and Praise to our beneficent Father who dwelleth in the Heavens."

For those history buffs, the context of President Lincoln's proclamation was in the midst of the Civil War. More specifically, it was after the battle of Gettysburg and Vicksburg where at least 8,000 soldiers had lost their lives. Times were uncertain as the nation battled against each other. And yet, in the midst of the turmoil, President Lincoln decreed to set aside a day for the entire nation to give God praise and honor.

President Lincoln further stated that the nation needed to rely on God's power to help those who had been hurt by the Civil War. He closed with a plea for the Almighty "to heal the wounds of the nation and to restore it as soon as may be consistent with the Divine purposes to the full enjoyment of peace, harmony, tranquility and Union."

And now 144 years later, we still have the privilege of setting aside time as a nation to thank God for

his abundance, to ask for his help and to praise our beneficent Father who dwelleth in the Heavens."

Give thanks to the LORD, call on his name; make known among the nations what he has done. Sing to him, sing praise to him; tell of all his wonderful acts. Glory in his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the LORD rejoice. Psalms 105:1-3

There are other great examples of men and women throughout the centuries who despite the times, the poverty, the abundance, the health or sickness, set aside time to thank God. Take for example the Lutheran Pastor Martin Rinkart, who grew up as the son of a poor coppersmith in the small town in Germany around the 17th century. As he began his pastoral ministry, the Thirty Years' War raged in Germany. He found himself in a country where plague, death, famine and fear were everyday occurrences. Yet despite the desperate situation, Rinkart believed in the importance of thanking God as evidenced in the hymn he wrote, "Now Thank We All Our God, which we now sing.

Now thank we all our God With hearts and hands and voices, Who wondrous things has done, In whom his world rejoices.


As we approach the holiday season, let's learn from past leaders who understood that thanks and praise belong to our God.

# Stewardship

One of the great blessings Gloria Dei has experienced is the generous giving of our members towards the growth of God's kingdom. Since 2000, our total congregational giving has gone from a little less than \$900,000 annually to almost \$1,500,000 during the last fiscal year. That is an increase of over 60 percent! God has truly blessed us.

While the increase in giving is important, it is more important what is accomplished with those resources. Consider the exciting things that have happened over that time period:

- We have opened a thriving Christian preschool which serves almost 100 children weekly.
- We have added the Northwind worship service on Saturday evenings, which 150-200 people weekly attend - allowing us to reach people in unique and exciting ways.
- We have supported missions worldwide. In the last year, a group from Gloria Dei made their third trip to Honduras on a medical mission trip that also brought Christ to the poor and needy in that country. We supported the building of a Christian church in China where none had existed. We made a second trip to Uganda to train and support the growth of the church there and funded a trip for two members of that church to the United States for additional training and support. None of these missions was active just five years ago.
- We have added support groups and care ministries
   where few existed before to serve the needs of our members and
   members of the community.
- We have grown our audio/visual capabilities to the point where we are now hosting concerts and other events in our facility and in the community as another way to reach people with the good news of Jesus Christ.

While the congregation and community have been blessed, so have those contributing to these exciting activities. Each person that has financially supported our ministry is blessed with the knowledge of what has been accomplished.

Consider the opportunities ahead and the blessings we could enjoy if we challenged ourselves, even in small ways, to further supporting the ministry. What if we could increase the current average family giving from 2.7 percent of income to even 3 percent? Consider the blessings if the fifty percent of our membership that currently gives less than \$5 per week to the ministry committed to giving 1 percent of their income. The opportunities for us to reach people are endless.

God has truly blessed Gloria Dei and we continue to look for new and innovative ways to continue bringing Jesus Christ to people for the first time and a lifetime.



#### **Weekends at Gloria Dei** Nursery

**Infants to age 3**. Located on the lower level, access is through the doors in the Narthex. The nursery is staffed during all worship services for children ages 3 and under at no cost to the parent.

#### **Cry Room**

Located in the southeast corner of the Narthex is a room for parents to take their small children to when they are upset or crying. This room allows full view of the Sanctuary and has full audio to hear the service.

#### **Families Worship Together**

With the exception of the 7:45 a.m. service, the first twenty minutes of each worship service is designed for families to worship together. At that point in the service, children and youth will be invited to join their peers in an educational time specifically for them as outlined below.

#### **Grace Place - Preschool and Elementary Children**

We offer Grace Place, our weekend educational time, for children ages 3 to fifth grade at three different times: Saturday from 5:50-6:30 p.m.; Sunday from 9:20-10 a.m.; and Sunday from 10:50-11:30 a.m. Children will be invited from worship to attend Grace Place. They will gather outside of worship and leaders will escort them to their classrooms.

#### Castaway - Youth

For our junior high youth in grades 6-8, we have a high-energy educational time, Castaway, in the Youth Center on Sundays at 9:20 and 10:50 a.m.

#### Senior High and Adults

Our senior high youth in grades 9-12 are invited to a study on Sundays from 9-10 a.m. in rooms 134-38.

Adults are invited to join us for an in-depth journey using materials from the Lifelight series in rooms 131-33 from 9:20-10:20 a.m, or a study that parallels the new sermon series from 10:20-11:20 a.m. in rooms 135-37.
