In the last several months, we have been working on several new initiatives that we believe will help to provide individual care to our members. Please take some time to read what will be available in the fall. If you or someone you know would benefit from one of these groups, please give me a call at 278-5544, ext. 204.

### **Stephen Ministries**

Beginning in September, Gloria Dei will begin the Stephen Series, a sequence of steps to implement the lay caring ministry system commonly referred to as Stephen Ministries. Earlier this year, Gloria Dei enrolled in Stephen Ministries joining 9,000 congregations worldwide. In September, we will begin training about a dozen Stephen minister candidates recruited from our congregation. The candidates will attend rigorous training in the fall and winter months and then be commissioned in the spring as Stephen ministers.

### Who are Stephen Ministers?

Stephen ministers are lay people who receive 50 hours of Christian care-giving training in the congregation. Stephen ministers typically have one care receiver at a time and meet with that person once a week for about an hour. In addition, they gather with their Stephen leaders twice a month for supervision and continuing education.



#### Nursery

Infants to age 3. Located on the lower level, access is through the doors in the narthex. The nursery is staffed during all worship services for children ages 3 and under at no cost to the parent.

#### **Cry room**

Located in the southeast corner of the narthex is a room with a full view of the sanctuary for parents to take their small children when they are upset or crying.

#### **Families worship together**

At both 9 a.m. services, families are encouraged to worship together before the children are invited to join their peers in an educational time specifically for them. Of course, if children would rather be with adults throughout the service, they are more than welcome.

#### Children

**Grace Place - preschool and elementary children:** We offer educational opportunities for children ages 2 thru grade 5. Each class is grade-level appropriate with lots of hands-on activities to help reinforce the lessons. Families are welcome to worship together before the children are excused for Grace Place 20 minutes into the service, or families can take their children to the classrooms.

**Junior High: Castaway:** For our junior high youth in grades 6-8, we have a highenergy educational time, Castaway, in the Youth Center on Sundays at 9 a.m.

### Communion

Communion is offered on the first and third Sundays of each month during the services in the Sanctuary and the second and fourth Saturdays and Sundays during the services in the Family Life Center.

A note to our guests and visitors: The Lord's Supper is celebrated at Gloria Dei in the belief and with the confession that this Sacrament is the very body and blood of Christ (The Doctrine of the Real Presence) which is received with the bread and the wine for us to eat and drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our faith. If you agree with our beliefs regarding the nature and meaning of this Sacrament and desire to commune with us, you are welcome! For the medical and/or physical needs of members or visitors, non-alcoholic wine will be in the inner circle of each communion tray and will be lighter in color than the regular wine.

# Weekly Bible Reading: Mark 9: 20-27

..... So they brought him. When the spirit saw Jesus, it immediately threw the boy into a convulsion. He fell to the ground and rolled around, foaming at the mouth. Jesus asked the boy's father, "How long has he been like this?" "From childhood," he answered. "It has often thrown him into fire or water to kill him. But if you can do anything, take pity on us and help us." " 'If you can'?" said Jesus. "Everything is possible for him who believes." Immediately the boy's father exclaimed, "I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief!" When Jesus saw that a crowd was running to the scene, he rebuked the evil spirit. "You deaf and mute spirit," he said, "I command you, come out of him and never enter him again." The spirit shrieked, convulsed him violently and came out. The boy looked so much like a corpse that many said, "He's dead." But Jesus took him by the hand and lifted him to his feet, and he stood up.
